<b>Maximum Sum Insured</b>	\$2,000,000
<b>Emergency Hospital</b>	Semi-private hospital accommodation
<b>Emergency Medical</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Services of physician, surgeon, anesthetist</li> <li>· Diagnostics, lab test and/or x-ray</li> <li>· Licensed local land and or sea ambulance. Up to \$150 for taxi expenses in lieu of ambulance</li> <li>· Private duty services of a registered graduate nurse up to \$15,000</li> <li>· Rental of medical appliances</li> <li>· Oxygen and rental of equipment</li> <li>· Blood and blood plasma</li> </ul>
<b>Professional Services</b>	Physiotherapist, chiropractor, chiropodist, osteopath, podiatrist, acupuncturist, naturopath and speech therapist up to \$600 per practitioner
<b>Drugs or Medications</b>	Up to \$10,000 not exceeding a one-month supply
<b>Maternity Benefit</b>	Up to \$25,000 for pre-natal care and involuntary termination of pregnancy or complications provided that pregnancy commenced during the period of coverage
<b>Eye Examination</b>	One visit during any 12 consecutive months
<b>Physical Examination</b>	One routine physical examination or one consultation for the "morning after pill" when 12 months has been purchased. Up to a maximum of \$150
<b>Emergency Air Transportation / Return home</b>	When pre-approved by Active Care Management
<b>Transportation of Family</b>	Up to \$5,000 to transport one family member and up to \$1,500 for meals and accommodation
<b>Non-Emergency Treatment</b>	Up to \$3,000 to continue medical treatment when pre-approved by Active Care Management
<b>Accidental Dental</b>	Up to \$5,000 for emergency treatment for accidental blow to the face
<b>Dental Emergencies</b>	Up to \$600 for the immediate relief of acute dental pain
<b>Wisdom Teeth</b>	Up to \$150 per tooth for extraction of impacted wisdom teeth
<b>Return of Deceased</b>	Up to \$15,000 for return of remains or up to \$5,000 for cremation or burial at place of death
<b>Accidental Death &amp; Dismemberment</b>	Up to \$10,000 Flight Accident and Common Carrier 24-Hour Accident
<b>Psychiatric and Psychological Care</b>	Up to \$25,000 for inpatient and up to \$1,000 for outpatient services
<b>Prescription Glasses, Contact Lenses, and Hearing Aids</b>	Up to \$200 when required as a result of accidental injury
